



SIGHT WORDS

Parents participate by reading activity flash cards while children use a rechargeable flashlight named Poindexter to light the words. It's especially fun at bedtime when the lights are out.

Learning Activities:

- 1. Read and practice words until learned by sight.
- 2. Choose one or more words and make a complete sentence.
- 3. Choose a word and use it in the form of a question.
- 4. Read a word for your child and have him or her repeat it and find it. You can give clues such as the starting letter or color of the word.
- 5. Play GUESS MY WORD: "It's a green word and has 5 letters. It starts with...."
- 6. Choose one or more words and create a story. Using your imagination is higher level thinking.
